

A portrait of the Swiss Red Cross

The Swiss Red Cross (SRC) is the National Red Cross Society of Switzerland and has its headquarters in Bern. It was founded in 1866 by General Guillaume Henri Dufour and the federal councillor Jakob Dubs. The SRC is the oldest and largest humanitarian organization in the country. It is a member of the worldwide Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement. The basic precept of this movement is to help people in need.

No other relief organization combines such a wide variety of strengths in the health, integration and rescue sectors as the Swiss Red Cross. The SRC Group comprises 24 cantonal associations and five corporate members (active members), three institutions, the SRC Headquarters, and the Secretariat of the cantonal associations.

The SRC and its members are supported by around 50,000 volunteers. Although their help is unremunerated, it is nevertheless invaluable.

The SRC and its staff, members and volunteers are committed to helping people in Switzerland in three key sectors: health, integration, and rescue. In addition, the SRC is continually developing its skills in voluntary work, youth work, and training.

In other countries the SRC focuses on disaster relief operations, reconstruction, and development cooperation. These activities are mainly carried out in areas that have been devastated by war and natural disasters and where health care is far from adequate to meet the needs.

In both its national and international activities the SRC is guided by the seven Fundamental Principles of the Red Cross: Humanity, Impartiality, Neutrality, Independence, Voluntary Service, Unity and Universality. They were first defined by the founder of the Red Cross, Henry Dunant (1828-1910).
